PRINCIPALS COMMENTS WELCOME BACK

On behalf of all the staff, I would like to extend a warm welcome to all our families. I sincerely hope everyone had an enjoyable holiday break and are keen to work hard throughout the year. A special welcome to all our new Movellians – Prep families and families of new students in other grades across the school. I hope you will have many wonderful experiences and memories during your time at Movelle.

We welcome new staff members to our school, Miss Hayden in Prep Room 1, Miss Agius 1/2 Room 5 and Mrs Cutri in Room 9. They have already started to settle in and contribute to our school.

All grades are settling into routines. Students and teachers are working hard on their academic progress. This week teachers and students have been collecting books and setting up their classroom libraries, ready for next week. Students should be reading or being read to, each night. Nightly reading by all students is a must to help students master reading and comprehension.

From time to time, issues arise that need to be addressed, please speak with your child's teacher as soon as possible to resolve minor issues. If you believe you have a major complaint, please make arrangements to see either myself (Mr. Hunt) or the Assistant Principal, (Mrs. Brooks) as soon as possible, so we can work together to resolve any issues.

ASTHMA, ALLERGIES & DIABETES—UPDATES.

If your child suffers from asthma, allergic reactions or diabetes, please let us know. It is essential that our staff and teachers are aware of the steps to put in place if the child has an asthma attack, allergic reaction or if their diabetes levels are unstable.

Therefore, all of these students must have an appropriate "management plan" that is signed by your doctor to assist us. Parents are asked to make arrangements with their doctor to update or establish the "management plan" as soon as possible.

NO PEANUT PRODUCTS IN PREPS PLEASE!

One of our students is severely allergic to peanut products, such as: peanuts, peanut butter, items cooked in peanut oil and chocolate bars that contain traces of peanut products. Therefore, we respectfully ask that all parents of students in Preps/1 avoid sending any related peanut products to school as food or

snacks. This can be a lifethreatening illness, and we seek your absolute cooperation on this matter please. Thank you!

SCHOOL TIMES

Students must be at school by 8:45am ready for a 9am start. Students who are late MUST be brought to the office by parents or carers to sign the students in. Our finishing time is 3:30pm and I would ask that parents are on time to pick up their children. Students, especially those in Prep, get quite anxious if their parents are not there to pick them up on time.

If parents / carers are going to be late to pick up their children, could you please ring the school and inform us of your anticipated time of arrival. If parents arrive after 3:45, your child may be placed into the After School Care Program .and you may be charged the casual rate .

USING THE PARENT CAR PARK AREA.

Parents may select to use the parent car park to drop off and pick up their child from school. There is an ENTRY gate and an EXIT gate. Please drive at speeds of 5 kph and be very aware of parents and students moving around. The car park is generally supervised by Anthony Nelson in the mornings and afternoons. All parents must obey Mr. Nelson's instructions to ensure the car park is a safe environment for all. Please be patient when others are trying to park or exit. Parents are also asked not to park in the parking areas that are reserved for vehicles that display a "Disabled" tag.

A reminder to parents that they are not permitted to park in the Staff Car Park.

UNIFORMS

Parents are reminded to clearly write their child's full name and room number on ALL pieces of clothing, including hats, jumpers and bags.

Remember that at Movelle we are a "Sunsmart School" and as such, all students must have a royal blue broad brimmed, bucket or legionnaire's hat that covers the head, neck and ears of students. Baseball type of caps are NOT allowed as substitutes. Hats can be purchased from the "Primary School Wear Shop" Westwood Drive Deer Park. Library bags can also be purchased at school for \$3.00.

SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS - 2013.
