PRINCIPAL'S COMMENTS

INDIVIDUAL INSURANCE FOR STUDENTS.

Each year the Education Department requires that I remind parents that students at schools do NOT have individual accident insurance. Therefore, in the case of an accident, where a child is seriously hurt; any medical, dental, physiotherapy, transportation or other associated costs will be charged to the parent, not the school or the Education Department. The **Education Department advises** that parents may take out private insurance from any number of insurance companies. If parents have a current Health Care card, or are on Centrelink benefits, most costs will be covered automatically.
