### LAPTOPS COMPUTERS FOR CHILDREN IN GRADES 5 & 6

At Movelle Primary School, we embrace the use of technology (computers) to strengthen students ability to access learning opportunities using the internet. In order to assist our students, we are going to introduce a Student Laptop Program this term for all students in the grade 5 and 6 area. Students will be able to access the use of a dedicated new laptop to use at school. The costs will be \$20 per term and will need to be paid in advance. As we hope to get the laptops into students' hands this term, we will require payment for part of term 3 and \$20 for next term, approximately \$30, but the amount will be finalised as soon as the laptops have been fully setup. Attached to this newsletter is an information letter which, when signed by the parents/ carer, will become an agreement contract between parent/carer and the school. When payment is made, your child will be able to use a new laptop to present work or to research topics. There is also an Acceptable Internet Policy Agreement that needs to be signed by the student.
